LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

INTRODUCTION

Right now your leadership skills are at a certain level. For the sake of teaching this principle we will measure leadership on a scale of 1 – 10. If your leadership skills are, for argument's sake on level 6, the effectiveness of your work and your ability to lead and influence others will never rise above that level. You cannot consistently produce on a level higher than your leadership level. In other words, your leadership skills determine the level of your success – and the success of those who work around you. “Were any great men born in Pretoria”? “Nope, - only babies”. Leadership is developed – not discovered.

- **Knowing** how to do the job is the accomplishment of labour.
- **Showing** others is the accomplishment of a teacher.
- **Making sure** the work is done by others is the accomplishment of a manager.
- **Inspiring others** to do better is the accomplishment of a leader.

WHAT IS LEADERSHIP?

Leadership is **influence**

Leadership is the ability to obtain **followers**.

He who thinks he leads and has no one following him is only taking a walk.

CLIMBING THE STEPS OF LEADERSHIP

There are five steps of leadership:

- a) Positional level
- b) Relationship level
- c) Production level
- d) People Development level (Reproduction)
- e) Integrity and Experience level

1. **THE HIGHER YOU GO, THE LONGER IT TAKES**

Each time there is a change in your job or you join a new circle of friends, you start on the lowest level again and begin to work yourself up the steps

2. **THE HIGHER YOU GO, THE HIGHER THE LEVEL OF COMMITMENT**

Greater commitment is demanded not only from you, but from the other individuals involved. When either the leader or the follower is unwilling to make the sacrifices a new level demands, influence will begin to decrease.

3. **THE HIGHER YOU GO, THE EASIER IT IS TO LEAD**

The focus shifts from “liking you”, to “liking what you do for the common interest of all concerned”. Each level climbed by the leader and the followers adds another reason why people will want to follow.

4. **THE HIGHER YOU GO, THE GREATER THE GROWTH**

Growth can only occur when effective change takes place. Change will become easier as you climb the steps. As you rise, other people will follow and even assist you in making necessary changes.

5. **YOU NEVER LEAVE THE BASE**

Each level rests upon the previous one and will crumble if the lower level is neglected. As you move up in the levels, the deeper and more solid your leadership will become with a person or group of people.

6. **IF YOU ARE LEADING A GROUP OF PEOPLE, YOU WILL NOT BE ON THE SAME LEVEL WITH EVERYONE**

Therefore, you will not have the same response from every one to your leadership.

7. **FOR YOUR LEADERSHIP TO REMAIN EFFECTIVE, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT YOU TAKE THE OTHER PEOPLE OF INFLUENCE WITHIN THE GROUP WITH YOU TO THE HIGHER LEVEL.**

If this happens, the combined influence of yourself and the other leaders will bring the rest along. If this does not happen, interest and loyalty within the group will be divided.

TAKE A LOOK AT EACH LEVEL

1. POSITIONAL LEVEL

- This is the basic entry level of leadership.
- The only influence you have is that which comes with a title.
- You may be "in control" because you have been appointed to a position.
- You may have authority – but real leadership is more than having authority or control.

A real leader knows the difference between being a boss and being a leader.

THE BOSS	THE LEADER
Drives his men	Coaches his men
Depends upon authority	Depends on good will
Inspires fear	Inspires enthusiasm
Says "I"	Says "we"
Fixes the blame for the breakdown	Fixes the breakdown
Knows how it is done	Shows how it is done
Says "GO"	Says "LET'S GO"

1.1 **SECURITY IS BASED ON TITLE, NOT TALENT**

The higher the person's level of influence, the more secure and confident he becomes.

1.2 **THIS LEVEL MAY BE GIVEN BY APPOINTMENT**

All other levels are gained by ability.

1.3 **PEOPLE WILL NOT FOLLOW A POSITIONAL LEADER BEYOND HIS STATED AUTHORITY**

They will only do what they have to do when they are required to do it. Low morale is always present. When the leader lacks confidence, the followers lack commitment.
